

WHAT IS AWSWM?

The Italian Agency for Development Cooperation (AICS) awarded the AWSWM consortium (Acronym for Access to Water and Solid Waste Management) with a grant to improve the availability and access to safe water and reduce the environmental impact of waste management for 138,287 individuals residing in 15 villages in the Union of Municipalities of Jurd Al Qaytea.

AWSWM is comprised of 3 partner organisations - CISP (lead agency), COOPI and ODA, in partnership with the North Lebanon Water Establishment and The Union of Municipalities of Jurd Al Qaytea.

AWSWM contributes to the achievement of Sustainable Development Goals 6 and 11

AWSWM is implemented between September 2022 and August 2025, with a total budget of 3,7 million Euros. From the total budget, 3,5 million Euros are funded by AICS and the remaining amount is contributed by CISP, COOPI and ODA.

AWSWM GOALS

1. Improve the drinking water network and use of drinking water in Hrar and Bzal
2. Improve the Solid Waste Management system in Jurd Al Qaytea

AWSWM ACTIVITIES

1. Water infrastructure works in the villages of Hrar and Bzal
2. Water awareness sessions on water conservation, hygiene, water legal framework and water network subscriptions
3. Setting up a standardised municipal waste collection service
4. Establishment of Solid Waste Management Committees
5. Re-qualification and reclamation of illegal dumpsite near Nahr al-Bared river
