

### • Activity 5

40 women and adolescents with situation of risk (domestic violence, bullying, school withdrawal, gender based violence) individually followed for protection, organizing referrals to different needed agencies and resources



### ‘ The problem:

Lack of essential equipment and competence for women maternal and reproductive health, children and adolescent services.



### • Activity 1

- Provision of portable ultrasounds and accessories to Khallet Eddar, Khamlet Al Maiyya, and Beit Eynun.
- improved diagnostic services antenatal and gynecology.
- Provision of laboratory equipment for two small laboratories (Khallet Eddar and Khamlet Al Maiyya).
- improved access to basic hematochemical analysis.
- Provision of furniture, ACs in 2 clinics and small improvement works (painting and isolation form humidity) in 1-clinic.
- Improved conditions for patients waiting and consultation
- Provision of autoclaves and disinfection materials Khamlet Eddar, Khamlet Al Maiyya and Beit Eynun.
- improved infection prevention.



### • Activity 2

- 5 hand washing stations have been installed in the Health Clinics related to the communities of Khamlet Al Maiyya, Khamlet Eddar, Beit Eynun, Al Dairat and Abu Ayyash. The staff has been trained on the use and maintenance of the systems.
- In these clinics, not all patients had the opportunity to wash their hands. Sinks were often reserved for clinic staff. Thus, hand-washing stations make it possible to ensure hygiene within the clinics and also drastically reduce water consumption.
- By using hand washing stations instead of running water, the 5 clinics can save a total of about 5 cubic meters of water per week.



### • Activity 3

Trained 19 healthcare providers serving the targeted clinics/communities on the family planning, antenatal and post-natal care.



### Result 3

Improved the quality of essential health services for vulnerable communities in Area C, with a particular focus on services for women of reproductive age.

**Introduction:** The project aimed at contributing to the protection for the Palestinian population in target communities in the Hebron Governorate most exposed to violations of human rights, through actions aimed at increasing the availability of drinking & safe water, improving the quality of essential maternal & children health care services provided in ministerial clinics; strengthening community-level protection for women in reproductive age and adolescents of both genders; and advocate for the right to health and to water.







## Result 1

Improved access to safe and drinkable water at household and community levels

### The problem:

Lack access of healthy water, limited availability of safe water for hand washing which reduces the opportunity to practice health protection practices.



### Activity 1

150 Households Water Treatment and Safe storage systems distributed in 5 communities (Khallet Eddar, Khallet Al Maiyya, Beit Eynun, Zif, Al Dairat) supplying safe drinking water

**Impact:**  
- health situation.  
- saving money.

### Activity 2

extended the community water network by 1.3 km for Khalet Al Mayya connecting 98 buildings and 2.5 Km for Khalet Eddar, connecting 35 Buildings that had no access to safe water.

**Impact:**  
133 Buildings are now connected and have access to safe water.



## Result 2

Practices of prevention and response to hygiene-sanitation risks, protection and advocacy for the right to health improved with a particular focus on women of reproductive age and adolescents



### Activity 1

RANAs, 60 beneficiaries benefited from the information and behavioral change campaign on correct hygiene practices for drinking water use



### Activity 2

500 Basic Dignity Hygiene Kits distributed to 500 families/ 2979 individuals including explanatory leaflets on the use of hygiene items and basic health practices for women and children.



### Activity 3

10 days Training of 21 women to be community mobilizers and support their communities' awareness on SRHR, maternal health, healthy nutrition and lifestyle, infection prevention... ect



Informative material was developed, distributed and discussed with the beneficiaries.

### Activity 4

768 women and 478 children/adolescents participated in awareness and information sessions which were conducted in (30 in schools and 90 in different community locations) and led by Juzoor team and the trained women mobilizers on SRHR, maternal health, healthy nutrition and lifestyle, infection prevention... etc.
